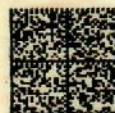

AWARD OF CERTIFICATE

Candidates are awarded a Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education if they pass in at least one subject at Principal level, or obtain at least a subsidiary pass in a subject offered at Principal level.

The word SUPPLEMENTARY on the front of the certificate indicates that the candidate sat for the examination on a second or subsequent occasion.

The grade of a pass at principal level awarded in a Uganda Advanced Certificate Principal subject is indicated by the letter A, B, C, D, or E. Grade A is the highest grade of pass, Grade E the lowest. Grade 'O' indicated that the candidate failed to pass at principal level but was allowed a pass at subsidiary level.

The grade of a pass awarded in a subsidiary subject is indicated by a numeric grade 1,2,3,4,5 or 6, grade 1 being the highest and grade 6 the lowest.
