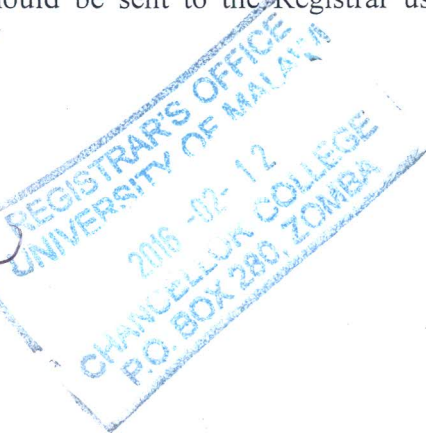

Miss F.L. Chiume joined the University of Malawi, Chancellor College in 2005.

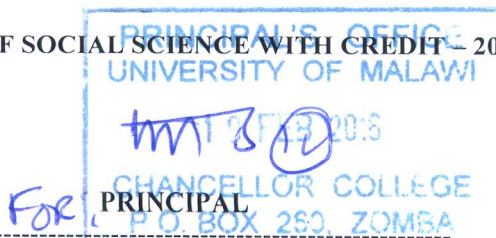
The basic **degree** course is of **four** years duration. Entry is based on the Malawi Schools Certificate of Education (equivalent to the British "O" level) or the equivalent.
