Applicants may also be admitted at the discretion of the University if they have a related Advanced Level certificate or diploma.

The duration of study for this program by holders of the MSCE or equivalent, extends over a period of not less than 4 academic years, that is, a period of 8 semesters of fifteen weeks each. Where applicable, advanced level candidates and diploma holders are given appropriate credits enabling them to complete their program in three and two years respectively.
