ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS – UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Route/Option- 1:

The academic requirement for the Undergraduate programmes is as follows: a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six credits that includes English and Mathematics. Specifically;

- Candidates should hold a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE), "O" Level or IGCSE with at least 6 credits including Mathematics and English. OR

Route/Option- 2:

Candidates may also be allowed to enter at third year provided they are:

- Holders of a Diploma in Business related field or any related field from a recognized institution of higher learning and an MSCE with at least four credits including Mathematics and English.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS – POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The academic requirement for the Postgraduate programmes is a relevant Bachelor's degree in any field of study from a recognized/accredited University/ Institution.

CLASSIFICATION OF AWARDS

A pass is awarded to a student with a minimum mean mark of 50% for in year 3 and year 4 and a mark of at least 50% in research for Undergraduates and a minimum mean mark of 50% in course work and a mark of at least 50% in research for Postgraduates.

A Credit is awarded to a student with a minimum mean mark of 60% in year 3 and year 4 and a mark of at least 60% in research for Undergraduates and a minimum mean mark of 60% in course work and a mark of at least 60% in research for Postgraduates.

A Distinction is awarded to a student with a minimum mean mark of 70% in year 3 and year 4 and a mark of at least 70% in research for Undergraduates and with a minimum mean mark of 70% in course work and a mark of at least 70% in research for Postgraduates.
