C. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission into this program, applicants must have the Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, with credits in English Language/Literature and an aggregate of not more than 30 points in the best 6 subjects obtained in not more than two sittings. Applicants may also be admitted at the discretion of the University if they have a related Advanced Level certificate or diploma.

The duration of study for this program by holders of the MSCE or equivalent, extends over a period of no less than 4 academic years, that is, a period of 8 semesters of sixteen weeks each. Where applicable, advanced level candidates and diploma holders are given appropriate credits enabling them to complete their program in three and two years respectively.

G. FINAL AWARD CLASSES

Bachelor of Social Science awards are classified as follows:

To be awarded a Distinction, the candidate must have accumulated an average of 80% or above through the 4 years of the program or the entire study period. The candidate will not have repeated any semester and should have a mark of 80% or above in Teaching Practice/Field Attachment.

To be awarded a Marginal Distinction, the candidate must have accumulated an average of 75% or above in the 4 years of the programme or the entire study period. The candidate will not have repeated any semester and should have a mark of 75% or above in Teaching Practice/Field Attachment.

To be awarded a Credit, the candidate must have accumulated an average of 65% or above through the 4 years of the program or the entire study period and should have a score of 65% or above in Teaching Practice/Field Attachment.

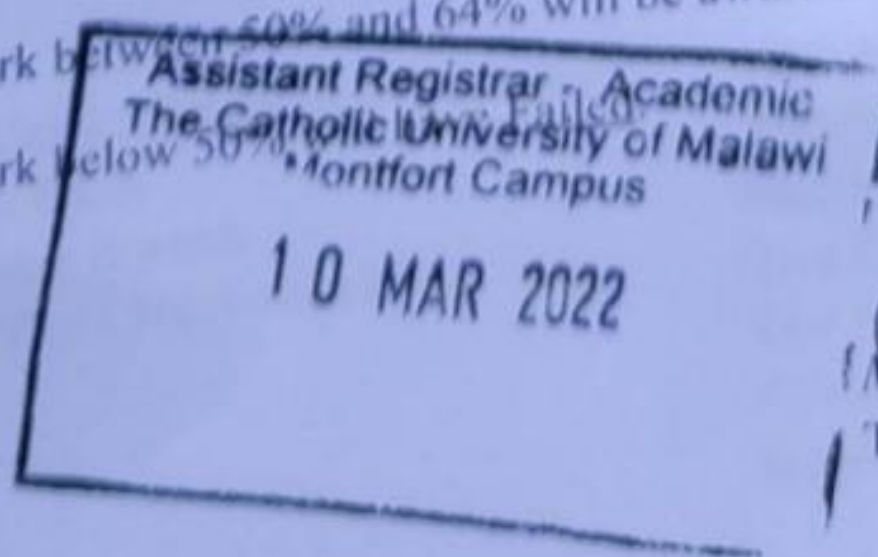
Candidates who accumulate an average mark of 50% or above through the 4 years of the program or the entire study period, but had repeated a semester or obtained a score of 64% or below in Teaching Practice/Field Attachment will be awarded a Pass.

Candidates who have accumulated an average mark between 50% and 64% will be awarded a Pass.

Candidates who have accumulated an average mark below 50% will be awarded a Fail.
