Second Class Honours, Upper Division (2i) will be awarded to a candidate who has achieved a mark ranging from 70% to 79.9% as a result of a cumulative average of level 3,4 and 5.

Second Class Honours, Lower Division (2ii) will be awarded to a candidate who has achieved a mark ranging from 55% to 69.9% as a result of a cumulative average of level 3,4 and 5.

Third Class Honours (3rd) will be awarded to a candidate who has achieved a mark ranging from 50% to 54.9% as a result of a cumulative average of level 3,4 and 5.
