SCHEME OF EVALUATION & GRADING

1. Evaluation of student performance in each course-unit has two components: (a) Internal Continuous Assessment (course work) and (b) the End Semester / Year Examinations which are held at the end of Semester / Academic Year.
2. The level of students' academic performance as the aggregate of continuous evaluation and End Semester / Year Examination is reflected by letter grades on a ten point scale according to the connotations given below

Non Teaching Credit Course is (e.g. Dissertation, Project etc.)			
1. NTCC with ≥ 15 credits have letter grades 'S' for Satisfactory and 'U' for Unsatisfactory			
2. NTCC with 'S' and 'U' Grade are not counted for calculation of SGPA/CGPA. 'S' Grade is mandatory for award of Degree			
3. NTCC with ≤ 15 credits have Grading. The Grade are counted towards calculation of SGPA/CGPA.

Non Teaching Credit Course is (e.g. Dissertation, Project etc.)

1. NTCC with ≥ 15 credits have letter grades 'S' for Satisfactory and 'U' for Unsatisfactory
2. NTCC with 'S' and 'U' Grade are not counted for calculation of SGPA/CGPA. 'S' Grade is mandatory for award of Degree.
3. NTCC with ≤ 15 credits have Grading. The Grade are counted towards calculation of SGPA/CGPA.

3. Course credit units are integer numbers indicating the weightage assigned to a course unit, project, research work, summer internship etc. on the basis of contact hours per week on all learning activities
4. Mandatory Course - Passing is Mandatory. Credit is not counted for calculation of SGPA/CGPA.

MINIMUM ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

- (1) The Student must score a minimum Grade 'C+' in each course unit. (2) Minimum Satisfactory Grade ('S') in NTCC
- (3) The minimum passing SGPA/AGPA for each semester/year is 4.5 for Under Graduate Programmes and 5.0 for Post Graduate, Integrated and Dual Degree Programmes.
- (4) The student should secure a minimum overall Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 5.0 in the case of Under Graduate programmes and 6.0 in the case of Post Graduate, Integrated and Dual Degree programmes at the end of final year

SEMESTER / ANNUAL GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The semester / annual performance of the student is indicated as "Semester / Annual Grade Point Average (SGPA/AGPA)" at the end of every semester / year. SGPA/AGPA is the weighted average of Grade Points of all letter grades secured by a student for all the course units in the Semester / Year. The formula for computing SGPA/AGPA is as under:

$$SGPA/AGPA = \frac{U1G1 + U2G2 + U3G3 + \dots}{U1 + U2 + U3 + \dots}$$

Where U1, U2, U3 ... denote units associated with the courses taken by the student and G1, G2, G3 ... are the Grade points of the letter grades awarded in the respective course units.

CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA)

The CGPA is used to describe overall performance in all courses in letter grades which a student has obtained. It is weighted average of grade points obtained by him in all the Semesters/Years.

$$CGPA = \frac{\text{Cumulative Grade Points Secured in all passed courses}}{\text{Cumulative Associated Credit Units}} \quad \text{i.e. } CGPA = \frac{U1G1 + U2G2 + U3G3 + \dots}{U1 + U2 + U3 + \dots}$$

CONVERSION OF CGPA TO PERCENTAGE OF MARKS

Conversion from CGPA to percentage of marks do not have rigor or rationale. However, an approximate and indicative equivalence between CGPA and percentage of marks can be assessed by multiplying CGPA by 10.

- 6.5 but less than 8.5
- 6.0 but less than 6.5
- 5.0 but less than 6.5
